Level 20 (senior students only)	Any first movement of a Haydn, Mozart, or Beethoven sonata not previously performed by this student in the Sonata Contest. <b>(No repeats)</b>
College Division	Any first or last movement of a Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven, or Schubert sonata not previously performed by this student in the Sonata Contest. <b>(No repeats)</b>
Adult (non-competitive)	Any movement of a sonata or sonatina not previously performed by this student in the Sonata Contest. <b>(No repeats)</b>

**Be aware that beginning with the 55<sup>th</sup> Sonata Contest held in 2024 Level One became non-competitive.**

Also be aware that Sonata Governing Rule No. 3 states no repeats are to be taken except in the case of a Da Capo, which completes the form of the piece. **If the committee deems a repeat to be taken, it will be listed on the repertoire sheet.**

**The judges will be given the specified editions.** If teachers choose to use other editions, it is their responsibility to resolve any discrepancies.
